The ultimate football tournament will grace the cities of South Africa in June and July 2010.

The host nation promises to deliver a colourful and vibrant tournament in the nine cities selected as tournament venues.

The qualifying nations are seeded and the draw places them into 8 groups of 4 teams.

The teams will each play 3 matches within the group and the winners and runners-up progressing to the Round of 16.

The competition then becomes a knock-out until the 2 finalists meet in Johannesburg's new Soccer City stadium on 11th July.

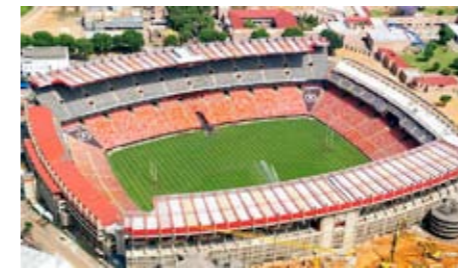

The Stadiums

South Africa - 11th June - 11th July 2010



Johannesburg
Capacity 61,000

The 10 stadiums will together host 64 matches and seat more than 570,000 people.

The five stadiums to be built from scratch are Green Point Stadium in Cape Town, Nelson Mandela Bay Stadium in Port Elizabeth, Durban Stadium in Durban, Mbombela Stadium in Nelspruit and Peter Mokaba Stadium in Polokwane.

The five to be upgraded are the Royal Bafokeng Stadium in Rustenburg, Free State Stadium in Bloemfontein, Loftus Versfeld Stadium in Pretoria, and Soccer City and Ellis Park in Johannesburg.

Port Elizabeth

The locals call Port Elizabeth 'Ten-Minute-City' — it's 10 minutes by car from the airport to downtown; 10 minutes from downtown to the beach and to three out of four local golf courses; and 10 minutes from the hotels to the big shopping centres.

Addo Elephant National Park - has the densest population of elephant in the world roaming in peace through this dense valley in the Sundays River region.

South Africa Whale Route - whales can easily be viewed from the shore. Southern Right whales visit between June and November, and Humpback whales are seen from May to December. The Bryde's whale stays all year round.

Durban

Ushaka Marine World - Durban's world class saltwater aquarium.

Battlefields - visit the internationally renowned KwaZulu-Natal Battlefields area of South Africa.

The Drakensberg Mountains, with their awe-inspiring basalt cliffs, snow capped in winter, tower over riverine bush, lush yellowwood forests and cascading waterfalls

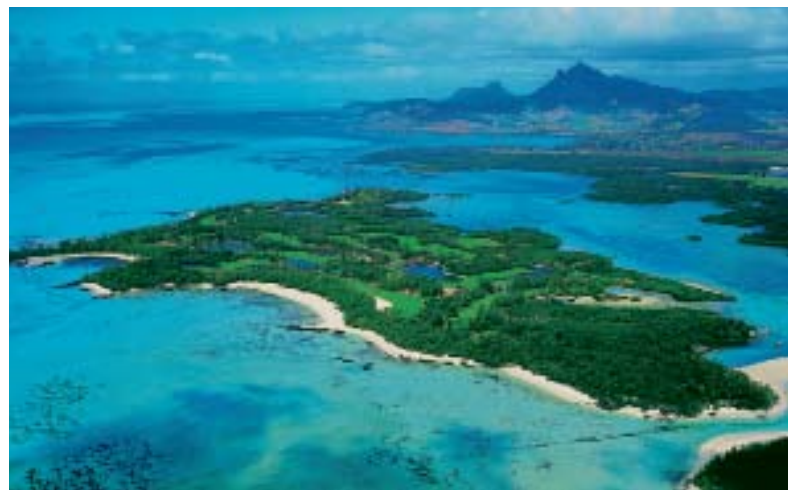

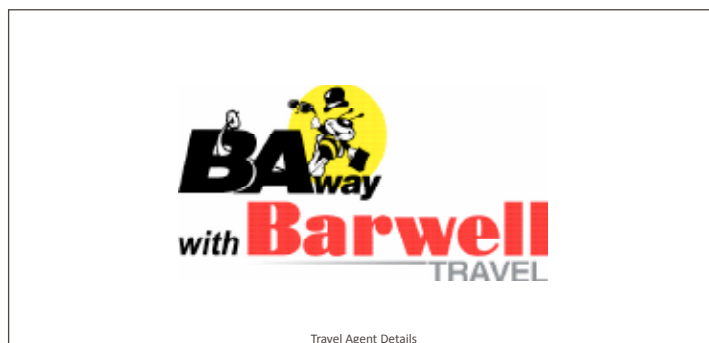
